


Getting to Moodle - August 2019

On the Scholars Online home page at <https://www.scholarsonline.org>, click on the dropdown *LOGON* menu, then on the *Moodle Access* option.



Enter your user id and password in the fields on the Moodle login page, then click on the *Log in* button.



On your home page, click on the *Orientation: Attend session, review logs* link under Navigation:
